

WHISTLER BOY TROPHY (Smallbore)



The Whistler Boy Trophies are identical bronze statuettes mounted on maple pedestals. They were donated to NRA in 1931 by Grover A. Hughes of Youngstown, OH, for annual Junior Smallbore Rifle competition in the NRA Instructor-Junior School at Camp Perry during the National Matches. Bronze plates on trophy bases originally showed Division A to be for the 12-14 age group and Division B for the 15-18 age shooters.

Match Conditions:

- 1931 An aggregate of 70 shots; 40 sitting, 20 kneeling and 10 standing.
- 1940 An aggregate of 110 shots; 50 prone, 30 sitting, 20 kneeling and 10 standing.
- 1956 Awarded each group in two different Junior and Tyro School. An aggregate of 40 shots at 50 yards; 10 prone, 10 sitting, 10 kneeling and 10 standing.
- 1959 Five shots in each of four positions at 50 yards.
- 1962 Ten shots prone and 10 sitting at 50 yards.
- 1963 Taken out of competition.
- 1978 Awarded to the winning Two-Member Junior State Association Team in the Hughes Trophy Junior State Association High Power Rifle Team Match of 10 shots slow fire, standing, 200 yards; 10 shots 200 yards, rapid fire sitting or kneeling from standing, 10 shots, 300 yards rapid fire prone from standing, 20 shots, 600 yards, slow fire prone.
- 1980 One of the pair awarded to the winning Whistler Boy Two-Member Junior State Association Team in the Smallbore Rifle Competition of a Dewar Match and a 60 shot 3-Position match (20 shots each; prone, standing and kneeling) each competitor. Possible team score of 2000. (Targets: A-23, A-25 and A-51).
- 1989 Conditions changed to allow Junior Club as well as Junior State Association Teams. (Targets: A-23, A-25 and A-51).
- 1990 As above but change Dewar targets to Metric A-51 and A-33.
