

STARK MEMORIAL POSITION TROPHY



The Stark Memorial Position Trophy (Coffee Pot) was donated to NRA in memory of Robert S. Stark, of Alexandria, VA, by his family. Robert S. Stark for many years supported Junior shooting in the Northern Virginia area helping many young shooters during their development. His son Matthew presented the trophy to the NRA for Junior competition at the U.S. International Shooting Championships in Phoenix, AZ in 1979. The Pewter Coffee Pot is part of an antique English hunt set brought from England in the late 1800's and given to Mrs. Stark's great grandmother's sister.

Match Conditions:

- 1979 Awarded to the Junior Standard Rifle 3 Position Champion.
- 1982 Re-designated for the winning Junior Smallbore Rifle 3-Position Team.
- 1997 Re-designated and awarded to the Sub-Junior 3-Position Champion at the Outdoor National Championship.
- 2008 Target changed to the NRA A-23/5 target.
